

## **Dual Enrollment**

Want to get a head start on college while still enrolled in high school? Dual Enrollment is the perfect opportunity for you. Vermont's Dual Enrollment Program allows high school students to take college courses while still enrolled in high school. Participating students earn college credits, reducing the time it takes to get a college degree, potentially reducing the cost associated with college, while challenging themselves through college level curriculum.

### **Eligibility**

Every Junior and Senior at Missisquoi Valley Union is eligible for two free college courses prior to graduation.

### **How It Works**

- Explore course options with your Guidance Counselor.
- Apply for a student account and dual enrollment voucher [dualenrollment.vermont.gov/vtde](https://dualenrollment.vermont.gov/vtde)

The voucher covers the cost of tuition for up to a 4-credit course at any of the participating colleges. The voucher does not cover the costs of materials and textbooks. Ask your Guidance Counselor how to receive financial assistance with those out of pocket expenses. Vouchers are awarded on a semester-by-semester basis.

## **Early College**

As a Vermont high school senior the Early College Program allows you to spend your senior year earning college credits that help you graduate and get a jump on your college degree, tuition free. Students in this program enroll full-time taking 4 – 5 college level classes during the fall and spring of their senior year for a total of 8 – 10 classes (24+ credits). Students use each institution's Early College application to apply. The application process involves meeting with your Counselor while getting endorsement from the High School Principal.
